- * Sensible and appropriate clothes for outings and school socials. Skimpy dresses, midriff and strapless tops and singlet tops are not permitted
- * A skirt/blouse or dress and a pair of shoes for special occasions
- * Clothing for Chapel - skirt, dress trousers or jeans with no rips/tears (skirts must cover the knees), and a blouse or shirt that covers the shoulders. No midriffs or low cut tops are permitted. Alternatively, girls may wear a dress that covers both the shoulders and the knees.
- * Closed in flat shoes (required for chapel) ie ballet flats
- * Neat casual clothing for wearing around the boarding house ie jeans / shorts / track pants / t-shirts / polo shirts - NO alcohol, cigarette or inappropriate advertisements are to be printed on clothing
- * Doona and doona cover
- * Pillow and pillow slip (the School provides sheets and blankets, and sheets are laundered once a week).
- * Pyjamas, dressing gown and slippers. (Will be needed in the event of a fire alarm)
- * Rubber thongs for showering
- * Mesh laundry bags (available at the uniform shop)
- All medication which, along with over the counter medication and vitamins, is to be handed in to the Medical Centre on arrival at the beginning of term.
- * Selected personal items ie photos of family/pets, trinkets, soft toys etc
- * Sun block and sun hat
- * Sleeping bag
- * Coathangers. As many as are required to accommodate clothing being brought to school by the student.
- * Swimwear (kneesuit or one-piece swimsuit only).
- * Sarong or Beach Dress (to be worn to and from the pool or swimming).
- * Small sewing kit (with extra name labels)
- * Shoe polishing kit
- * Wash / toiletry bag with all personal products needed for the Term. (No aerosols allowed).
- * Appropriate footwear
- * Washing detergent/fabric softener - in case your daughter wants to do some washing in the house machine.
- * A mug for tea or coffee
- * Consider packing some thermals - Armidale winters can get cold and your daughter may like to have them for the outdoor activities program

Prior to returning to school:

- * Label EVERY article of clothing and personal item with a name tag.
- * Clearly label all belongings, including watches, radios, calculators, iPods, phones etc.
- * Note that students are responsible for all personal possessions and are encouraged to lock away valuable items.
- * Note that all clothing goes to the laundry and the laundry is operated from Monday to Friday. A washing machine and clothes dryer are also available in house.
- * Note that the School cannot take responsibility for lost, borrowed or damaged articles of clothing or other personal possessions.
- * Any electrical item brought to school ie hairdryer, hair straightener etc must be tested and tagged by an authorised electrician, prior to being used at School.

Students must NOT bring:

- * Televisions
- * Refrigerators
- * Electric blankets
- * Electrical games – i.e. Play Stations, Nintendo DS etc.

Remember - there is limited space available. Do not bring too much to start with.
