

Year 9 and 10 Electives - 2017

Please find below an outline of the electives now on offer for Years 9 and 10 in 2017.

In the coming few days, students will receive an email from me with login details to access their web-choice form. They are required to enter their first **three** preferences in each elective line for Semester 1 only. Choices for Semester 2 electives will be done during Term 2, 2017. Students will have until **Friday 14th October** to complete this survey. Changes after this date can be requested via an email to Mrs Wark though not all requests will be able to be accommodated. All students will be notified of their allocated classes for 2017 before the end of Term 4.

Preference will be given to students in Year 10 and students who have chosen subjects in the initial survey conducted during Term 3. Enrolment in extension courses will be determined based solely on performance in core subjects in the previous twelve months and Coordinator recommendations.

Notes

1. Please refer to the subject handbook when choosing subjects. Students in Year 10 are advised to speak with their current teachers and advisor to ensure that they are choosing appropriate electives that complement what they have studied in Yr 9 and are not a repeat of what they have studied this year.
2. It is our intention to run all of these classes in 2017. However, if student numbers are too low to make a class viable then we may need to adjust the offering. If this occurs students will be notified and given a chance to switch to other courses.
3. Students in Year 8 should consult with Mrs Pollard about whether they should choose Curriculum Support in Year 9 – this is where additional literacy support and support for assignments in other subjects is given. Students most suited to this course would usually be already working with Mrs Pollard this year.
4. Students wanting to study French Continuers, Japanese Continuers or Music 2 in Year 11 and 12 should be studying a related subject each semester during years 9 and 10.
