Compass attached to boat

Cyalumes and boat number issued at registration and scrutineering

Boat number holder – already on all TAS boats

Sunscreen and sun glasses

Recommended Equipment

Thermals: two full sets and a third top

Bike shorts or board shorts

Breathable spray jacket

Canoe boots or shower shoes

Wet bag

Sponge

Bladder (2 or 3 litre) x 2

Simple first aid kit

Fluoro marking on boat

Paddler's land equipment

Two sets of casuals for the trip down and back. One is usually a track suit that can be accessed at the finish to change into.

Towel

Toiletries

One bag for personal gear

One bag for wet gear

One end bag

One Camp seat per paddler for boat setup

Entry requirements

Entry slip

Raffle books

Receipt books

Landcrew Equipment

Personal headtorch and/or torch (waterproof)

Large sponge for mopping out boat

Wet weather gear

Gumboots or water gear

Personal clothing and toiletries

Basic first aid

Sleeping bag or swag (Sat night)
