Donation	\$100 Jnrs \$200 Adults	Raised through raffle ticket sales or donations
Paddlers Dinner	\$25	Includes guest speakers, race briefing, race notes and equipment display. 3 Course meal
Grafton Practice Paddle	\$60	Bus, food and accommodation
1 <sup>st</sup> Bill at this point	September	
Myall Lakes Paddle	\$80	Bus, food and accommodation
Bus to Hawkesbury	\$60	Return from Armidale
Accommodation UWS, Friday night	\$55 + \$6 breakfast (\$44 each for a twin)	Single room only. Made bed with towel and soap. Light breakfast
Meals during race	\$24	4 meals from lunch Sat to breakfast Sunday
Logistics	\$40 for paddlers, \$20 for each landcrew	Covers getting boats and gear to training and the race and setting up at checkpoints
Boat hire	\$50 to \$90 per paddler dependent on boat	Covers use of boats and trailers during training and the event
Gear hire	\$40 per paddler	Use of pfd, decks and paddles during training and the race
Malpas Dam	\$20	Covers BBQs and equipment used during training

Landcrew pay the same costs as paddlers depending on their transport and accommodation with the exception of logistics (which is **\$20**) plus food during the event (**\$24**). They also pay any camp fees or entry charges incurred at various checkpoints during the event.
