

Hawkesbury Canoe Classic Training Information about the Myall Lakes Classic

The Myall Classic is going to be held one month before the Hawkesbury Classic on the first weekend of school holidays. It is a charity paddle to raise money for the "Cure For Life Foundation".

It is an ideal training paddle in preparation for the Hawkesbury. It is a 47km paddle that starts at Tea Gardens on the Myall River, goes up to Tamboy and back to the start again. The race begins at 9am on Saturday the 25th of September and will be completed before 4pm.

Two people have entered the race already through TAS and if we get enough interest, we will organise to take a bus with boat trailer down but we would need to know numbers by the 22nd of August as accommodation would need to be arranged for Friday and Saturday nights.
