

# RUGBY DRESS CODE for TAS STUDENTS

## What to wear when playing:

# 1<sup>st</sup> XV: TAS 1<sup>st</sup> XV jersey, white shorts, TAS 1<sup>st</sup> XV striped socks.

# 2<sup>nd</sup> XV: TAS 2<sup>nd</sup> XV jersey, TAS blue rugby shorts, TAS blue rugby socks.

# All other teams: TAS rugby jersey, TAS blue rugby shorts, TAS blue rugby socks.

# Note: All players must wear a mouth guard. Head gear and shoulder pads are optional.

## What to wear when travelling

**Opens teams:** No. 1 uniform including Honours blazer.

### All other teams:

# full TAS track suit, which includes TAS track suit pants **not** some other brand-named track pants.

# a TAS sports polo shirt. This could be either:

- (a) a TAS polo shirt from a rugby tour.
- (b) a TAS polo shirt from another TAS sport, eg cricket or tennis.
- (c) a TAS 'Sports' polo shirt, embroidered with the TAS crest.

# blue shorts

# sports socks

# joggers, NOT 'boat shows' or similar brown shoes

# TAS cap and/or TAS bucket hat and/or TAS blue beanie (no other coloured caps or beanies)

## What to wear when stopping to eat

The same as for travelling except for the following changes. When getting off the bus to eat, at McDonalds, beanies and caps **may not** be worn. Rugby jerseys may only be worn if covered by a TAS tracksuit top. Polo shirts must be tucked in.
