PARENT/STUDENT AGREEMENT

Name of Student:

Whilst on exchange you are acting as an ambassador of Australia and of The Armidale School. Your time in the exchange school will have a profound affect on your life as well as TAS as a whole. Our contact with the host school is very much long term and it is therefore our expectation that your behaviour and involvement will be exemplary.

Please read and understand the following points before signing below.
The exchange student must:

1. Abide by the regulations of the particular school.
2. Abide by the laws of the host country.
3. Act as a positive member of the host school, boarding house or host family, accepting the responsibilities and duties this entails.
4. Be aware that travel within the country is only permitted when accompanied by a staff member, host parents or when participating in an organised trip. At any other time, travel will only be with the permission of the host house master/mistress or head of the host school.
5. Carry both travel and health insurance for the duration of the stay.
6. Agree not to engage in any of the following during the period of exchange and understanding that continuation of the exchange may be jeopardised resulting in your return to Australia:
 - being absent from school without proper permission;
 - drinking alcohol, smoking or taking narcotic drugs;
 - driving motorcycles or motor vehicles;
 - breaching other rules and regulations of the host school.
7. Agree that on return from exchange you will prepare a written report and report back personally to the school community, in school and/or house assemblies and become involved in Round Square activities in the school.
8. Agree that on return from exchange I will endeavour to make up any academic work lost.
