- Label EVERY article of clothing and all personal clothing items with a **name tag**.
- Clearly label all belongings, including watches, radios, calculators, iPods, phones etc.
- Students are responsible for all personal possessions and are encouraged to lock away valuable items.
- All clothing can go to the school laundry and the laundry operates daily from Monday to Friday. Uniforms must be laundered by the school laundry. Failure to do so, may result in the items not being accepted in our preloved section at the Uniform Shop.
- Please note that the School cannot take responsibility for lost, borrowed or damaged articles of clothing or other personal possessions.
- Any electrical item brought to school ie hairdryers, powerboards etc must be tested and tagged by an authorised electrician, prior to being used at School.
- All medication, along with over the counter medication and vitamins, are to be handed into the Medical Centre on arrival at the beginning of term. This includes all medications including panadol etc.
