# WELCOME TO Co-curricular for term 2

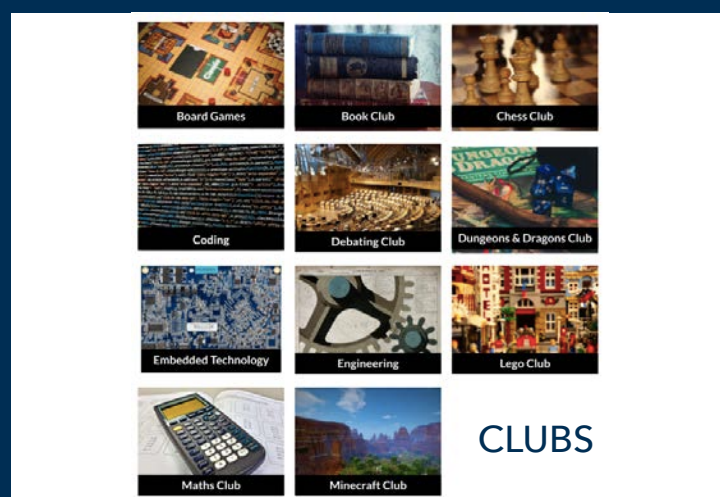
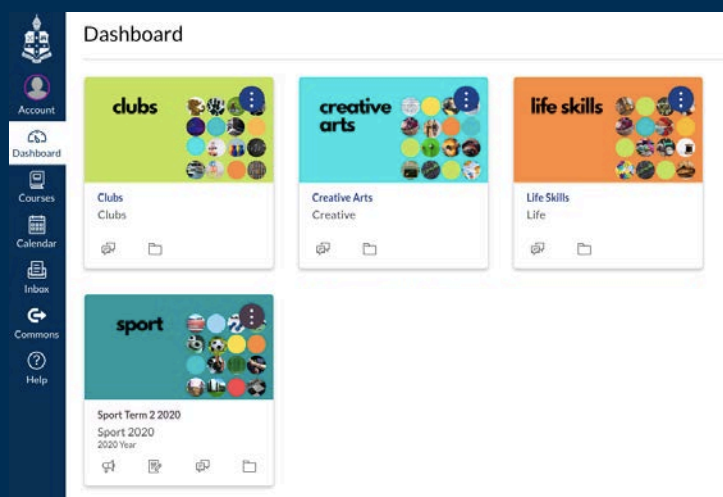
