Driving to School Regulations

1. While permission is normally readily granted no student is to drive to school without first obtaining such permission.
2. No day student vehicles are to be brought onto the School premises under any circumstances. This rule applies equally to holidays and week-ends as well as normal school days.
3. All boarders vehicles are to be parked in the marked spaces at Abbott and Croft Houses or on the gravel area near the Tennis Court Car Park.
4. The School does not accept responsibility for any loss or damage to vehicles.
5. All vehicles on the School property or in its periphery are totally out of bounds to all but the owners/drivers.
6. Between arrival and departure vehicles are out of bounds to their drivers (except with Deputy Head of School's permission) i.e. they are not to be used for joy rides, visits to shops etc. during the school day.
7. No student may give a lift to any other student unless parental consent, in writing from the parent of the passenger, is obtained and presented to the Deputy Head of School.
8. Any breach of these rules or of normal traffic regulations, or any use of the vehicle which is considered by staff to be dangerous or ostentatious will result in the immediate withdrawal of permission to drive to School.
