They are required to enter their first **three** preferences in each elective line **for Semester 1 only**. Students will have until **Friday 23 October 2020** to complete their choices. All students will be notified of their allocated classes for 2021 before the end of Term 4.

Preference will be given to students in Year 10. Enrolment in extension courses is limited to students currently in the Extension class or by direct negotiation with the Coordinator of that subject.
