

# 2021 Armidale Basketball Blurb– Term 1

## Round 1 – Saturday 6 February



Hi Everyone,

- I have completed the first round of the draw for term 1. If you see any issues, please contact Judy immediately. Not all teams are in at this stage, it is still a work in progress. There is a significant decline in women's team numbers, something which will have to be discussed with all stakeholders.
- I will put the team lists (as I know it) on the website and Facebook page tomorrow for everyone to check out and confirm.
- The referees and supervisors will be added tomorrow, so expect a second update.
- We have a beautiful new carpark for you all to park in. Please use it – carefully. While not confirmed, the speed limit will be around 15km/hr and you must be considerate when exiting the property as we do not wish to upset neighbours.
- Entry to the stadium is via the front door only (even if the side doors are open for the air flow). One of the side doors will be marked as an exit only to assist the traffic flow.
- All non-players must sign in using the Q code or the sheet.
- If you do not have your own set of uniforms in the senior competition, you will be given numbered bibs to wear.
- In 2021, all players must be financial. NSW is clamping down on Associations who do not ensure that their players are registered before they take the court. Please assist us by making sure your registration is current and that you pay the game fees for the upcoming term. Players must pay registration and game fees.
- Players can get online, fill in the national registration form and pay online. For previous players - check at [member.basketball.net.au](http://member.basketball.net.au) to see if and when your membership with NSW is due. Go to [armidale.basketball.net.au](http://armidale.basketball.net.au) to our website and you will find the 'Annual Registration Form' button to the right hand side and follow the instructions. Give me a call if there are any queries. Do not use the back button with this system when you are a new player putting in your details as it creates multiple players. Remember, registration is in 2 parts – State and Local. The 2 parts will add up to \$50, \$80 or \$100.
- Game fees are \$65 per term in terms 1 for Monday and Wednesdays while those playing junior mixed it is \$55 for their first and only game played. Players who are in two teams must pay 2 lots of game fees.
- Active Kids Vouchers (AKV) – You can use your AKV to pay online up to the value of \$100. Just follow the directions. If your costs are less than \$100, you can pay for registration and/or game fees and send a copy of the AKV (along with child's DOB) to [armball@bigpond.com](mailto:armball@bigpond.com) and we can reimburse you monies that you have just paid. We cannot redeem the AKV for cash where no purchases have been made – they must be used for an activity.

- The delayed **Annual General Meeting** has now been scheduled for Wednesday 3 March at 8pm at a venue to be confirmed. It is imperative that members support the meeting to enable basketball to continue. A quorum must be established. We need to get a full committee together to help basketball to continue to function. Committee members are only players who are willing to help out. Jump on board and help basketball to continue into the future. All positions are available, including general board members who help make decisions.

## **How to pay Registration and game fees online**

The costs in basketball include an annual registration fees plus game fees paid each school term.

### **Seniors, Juniors, Miniballers**

Annual registration fees are \$100 for players turning 18 or more in 2021 (senior), \$80 for those turning 12-17 or \$50 for those turning 11 or less and are in 2 parts (NSW component and Armidale component). Please ensure you pay both parts.

Go to [armidale.basketball.net.au](http://armidale.basketball.net.au) and click on the 'Register Now' button on the right hand corner of the website. Follow the procedure to pay annual registration and/or term game fees. Make sure you tick the circle for the term fees you wish to pay and add in the number of fees to pay per child eg 1 or 2 lots of fees (for those who play in 2 grades)

If you have forgotten the email you used, contact Judy to get updated.

### **Aussie Hoops**

Primary school children 12 and under can choose to register by the term. New players will get a ball, singlet and bag as well as the term fees for an initial fee of \$100. Returning players pay \$65 for the term fees.

Register on their website at [www.aussiehoops.com.au](http://www.aussiehoops.com.au) . Registration is compulsory and ensures we remain affiliated with NSW Basketball. Players in yrs 3-6 can participate in both Aussie Hoops and Minibasketball for no extra costs.

You must be fully registered to be able to pay game fees via Sports TG. This can only be done online and for a full 12 months. If you are already registered, you can pay term game fees online, pay cash at the stadium or do a direct deposit. We are directing out deposits to Armidale Basketball's account at the Newcastle Permanent this year.
