Dear Year 7 Students and Parents,

The following calendar outlines the class tasks that are scheduled during the year to assess students' learning. In Year 7, we refer to these tasks as Class Tasks, as opposed to formal assessment tasks as used in the Senior School. This is to ensure a smooth and age-appropriate transition from assessment used in Primary Schooling to assessment tasks used in a senior setting. Teachers will be informally assessing learning during lessons on an ongoing basis, so that they can adjust their teaching program to suit the students in their class.

Students in Year 7 are all part of a Class Task Canvas Page where this schedule is also available. More information about each Class Task will be uploaded to Canvas at least one week prior to the date of the task. This will outline what is required to be done, when the task is due, the subject, brief details of the task, and whether the task will be completed at home or in class.

PDHPE has a number of practical tasks that are held in class time but require no preparation at home. Students will be notified of these tasks, but they do not appear on the calendar below.

In some situations, it may be required to adjust the timing of these tasks due to unforeseen circumstances. In the case of this happening students will still receive notification as well as being told of the change as early as possible.
