Senior School (Yr 9 – 12)	<p>Years 9 and 10</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 8 x 96 or 128pg A4 Exercise books for each subject students study • 1 x 128 page Grid Book (5mm) for Maths • Headphones • Automotive/Metals/Ag-Liquid Gold elective students: 1 x pair of overalls (available at TAS Uniform and Book Shop) • Optional: Math-o-Mat (available at the TAS Uniform & Book Shop) <p>Years 11 and 12</p> <p>Students are able to choose whether they wish to use A4 128 page binder books or loose-leaf A4 folders. However, there will be times when work must be completed on loose-leaf paper. It is our suggestion that students have at least one large A4 folder for each subject that is studied that is not brought to school where work can be transferred to when not being used in class.</p>
